



At Vero Radiology Associates, we are working to deliver imaging services with the highest level of safety for both patients and caregivers during this COVID-19 pandemic. We are currently operating to perform emergent and semi-emergent studies according to guidelines established by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), Center for Medicare/Medicaid Services (CMS), American College of Radiology (ACR), American College of Surgeons (ACS), Cleveland Clinic, and the National Comprehensive Cancer Network (NCCN).

In an effort to control the spread of the disease, Vero Radiology Associates is requiring that all patients and employees wear a cloth mask while inside the facility. If you have an appointment and arrive without a mask, Vero Radiology will provide a temporary cloth mask that can be placed in a receptacle upon leaving for cleaning and reuse. We will be conducting temperature screenings and asking patients a series of questions before entering the building. To be mindful of social distancing, we will restrict the number of people to ten on either side of the lobby and ask that any accompanying guests remain outside. If you need to pick up contrast or medical records, lab orders or want to schedule an appointment, we will accommodate those requests outside of the building. Any appointments that have been placed on hold, that have not already been rescheduled, will be as soon as possible.

We are all in this together and are here for you during this time. Everyone at Vero Radiology Associates is aligning with Cleveland Clinic guidelines by washing hands often, wearing masks, maintaining social distancing, and cleaning surfaces and equipment often.
